What Does The Acura B1000 Code Mean?

This code indicates failure from the communication bus line.

Note: DTCs [B1005](#), [B1007](#), [B1011](#), [B1012](#), [B1013](#), [B1015](#) and [B1032](#) may all be indicated.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Acura B1000 Code?

Below are some possible causes of this DTC:

- Intermittent failure in the communication bus line. Check for loose or poor connections, or worn/shorted wires
- Poor battery condition and/or charging system
- Short to power in B-CAN wire
- Faulty MICU, replace the under-dash fuse/relay box
