# What Does The Acura B1015 Code Mean?

Poor communication MICU and the Driver's MPCS unit. If DTCs <u>B1065</u>, <u>B1082</u>, <u>B1356</u>, <u>B1358</u>, and/or <u>B1905</u> are indicated with <u>B1013</u> and/or B1015. Perform the driver's MPCS unit input test

# What Are The Potential Causes Of The Acura B1015 Code?

- Loose or poor connections between the MICU and the driver's MPCS unit
- Blown fuse in the main under-hood fuse box
- Blown fuse in the under-dash fuse/relay box
- "Open" or "Short" to ground at driver's MPCS unit
- "Open" or "Short" to ground at driver's MICU unit
- Faulty power window switch
- Faulty power window relay
- Faulty power window motor
