What Does The Acura B1157 Code Mean?

Poor communication between the Gauge Control Module and the MICU If DTCs [B1055](#), [B1056](#), [B1057](#), [B1255](#), [B1955](#), [B2155](#), [B2156](#), and/or [B2161](#) are indicated, perform the MICU input test. If no additional codes are indicated perform the Gauge Control Module input test.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Acura B1157 Code?

- Loose or poor connections between the Gauge Control Module and the MICU
- Blown fuse in the main under-hood fuse box
- Blown fuse in the under-dash fuse/relay box
- "Open" or "Short" to ground at the Gauge Control Module
- "Open" or "Short" to ground at the MICU
- Faulty Gauge Control Module
- Faulty MICU
