What Does The Acura B1171 Code Mean?

Poor communication between the gauge control module and adaptive cruise control unit.

NOTE: If you are troubleshooting multiple DTCs, be sure to follow the instructions in B-CAN System Diagnosis Test Mode A.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Acura B1171 Code?

- Faulty battery or charging system
- Perform the gauge control module input test
- Blown fuse
- Loose or poor connections
- "Open" or "Short" circuit between the gauge control module and adaptive cruise control unit
- Poor ground
- Faulty gauge control module
- Faulty adaptive cruise control unit
