What Does The Acura B1955 Code Mean?

Poor communication between the Rear Fuse/Relay Box and the MICU.

NOTE: If you are troubleshooting multiple DTCs, be sure to follow the instructions in B-CAN System Diagnosis Test Mode A.

If DTCs <u>B1055</u>, <u>B1056</u>, <u>B1057</u>, <u>B1157</u>, <u>B1159</u>, <u>B1180</u>, <u>B1255</u>, <u>B1955</u>, <u>B2155</u>, <u>B2156</u>, and/or <u>B2161</u> are indicated, perform the MICU input test.

If no codes are present, perform the rear MICU input test.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Acura B1955 Code?

- Loose or poor connections between the Rear Fuse/Relay Box and the MICU
- Blown fuse in the main under-hood fuse box
- Blown fuse in the under-dash fuse/relay box
- "Open" or "Short" Condition between the Rear Fuse/Relay Box and the MICU
- Faulty MICU Under-Dash Fuse/Relay Box.
- Faulty Rear Fuse/Relay Box and the MICU
