### What Does The Chevrolet P1412 Code Mean?

The Ignition is ON. The battery voltage is greater than 11 V. The EGR cooler bypass valve control circuit is active. The starter is not cranking. The DTCs run continuously when the above conditions are met. The ECM detects that the EGR cooler bypass valve low, close, control circuit voltage is greater than a calibrated threshold for greater than 3 s.
