Voltage supplied to the module is in the normal operating voltage range of 9-16 volts. Diagnostic trouble codes <u>U1300</u>, <u>U1301</u> and <u>U1305</u> do not have a current status. The vehicle power mode, ignition switch position, requires serial data communication.

Some modules may not have internal protection for specific voltage outputs and may open a battery positive voltage or ignition voltage source fuse.
