What Does The Dodge B1A67 Code Mean?

Anytime the Key is placed in the ignition, this code is set immediately when the Wireless Control Module detects the (F892) Ignition Switch Output circuit shorted to ground or if the shaft bolt is stuck when the ignition key is removed.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Dodge B1A67 Code?

- (F892) ignition switch output (key-in) circuit shorted to ground
- Steering column lock module (ELV)
- Wireless control module (WCM)
