What Does The Dodge P1287 Code Mean?

Engine started and the PCM detected the Fuel Injection Pump battery voltage was too low.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Dodge P1287 Code?

- Fuel injection pump ground circuit is open
- Generator voltage is less than 12.0v (the Generator has failed)
- Battery voltage is less than 8.0v (the battery is defective)
- PCM has failed
