What Does The Dodge P1751 Code Mean?

Engine started; and the TCM detected a malfunction in the A/T Control Relay circuit, and then sent a signal to the PCM indicating that the malfunction had occurred

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Dodge P1751 Code?

- A/T control relay circuit is open, shorted to ground or to power
- A/T control relay power circuit is open (test power to Fused B+)
- A/T control relay is damaged or has failed
- PCM has failed
