What Does The Honda B1007 Code Mean?

Poor communication between the MICU and the Combination Switch Control Unit. Inoperative or intermittent Headlamp Switch.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Honda B1007 Code?

- Loose or poor connections between the MICU and the Combination Switch Control Unit.
- Blown fuse in the main under-hood fuse box
- Blown fuse in the under-dash fuse/relay box
- Faulty MICU
- Faulty Headlamp Switch (Combination Switch Control Unit).
