What Does The Mazda P1444 Code Mean?

Key on or engine running and the PCM detected the EVAP Purge Flow (PF) sensor signal was less than 0.20v during the CCM test.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Mazda P1444 Code?

- Purge flow sensor signal circuit is shorted to ground
- Purge flow sensor power circuit is open
- Purge flow sensor is damaged or has failed
- PCM has failed
