This code is set when the Heater Air Intake Duct Sensor circuit (power supply side and ground side) is open.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Mitsubishi B1002 Code?

- Malfunction of connector
- Malfunction of the harness
- Malfunction of the heater air intake duct sensor
- Malfunction of the A/C-ECU
