### What Does The Mitsubishi B1486 Code Mean?

When a malfunction is detected in the output transistor inside the SRS-ECU. However, if the vehicle condition returns to normal, DTC B1486 will be automatically erased, and the passenger seat belt warning light will go out.

### What Are The Potential Causes Of The Mitsubishi B1486 Code?

- Damaged wiring harnesses or connectors
- Malfunction of the SRS-ECU
