Key on, and the PCM detected an unexpected "low" voltage condition on the A/T Diagnosis Signal circuit (5-volt) in the CCM test.

What Are The Potential Causes Of The Subaru P1595 Code?

- Check harness between ECM and TCM connector
- Check output signal for ECM
- Check any other DTC on display
