Ignition off. The Evaporative Emission (EVAP) canister purge regulator valve in the tank venting system or activation wire has a short circuit to ground. Engine started, engine running at a steady cruise speed, canister vent solenoid enabled, and the ECM detected an unexpected voltage condition on the Canister Vent solenoid circuit.

## What Are The Potential Causes Of The Volkswagen P1426 Code?

- Activation wire has a short to ground
- ECM has failed
- EVAP canister has failed
- EVAP canister system has an improper or broken seal
- Evaporative Emission (EVAP) canister purge regulator valve 1 is faulty
- Leak Detection Pump (LDP) is faulty
